- All our transactions are subject to the Belgian Freight Forwarding Standard Trading Conditions 2005 (see on our website) , published in the Annexe of the 'Moniteur Belge' dated June 24th, 2005 under the number 0090237.
- Handling and storing of goods and all related activities performed in the ports of Antwerp and/or Zeebrugge, are performed in accordance with the ABAS-KVBG General conditions for the handling of goods and related activities (see on our website) as registered at the Chamber of Commerce and Industry Antwerp on March 26th, 2009.
Handling and storing of goods and all related activities performed in Belgium, outside the ports of Antwerp and/or Zeebrugge, are performed according to the General Logistic Conditions, registered by the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Antwerp and Waasland on November 27th, 2003 (see on our website).
- In case we issue Bills of Lading, acting as NVOCC-agent, the national Law of the Sea at the port of loading applies.
- In case we issue House Airway Bills, the provisions of the Montreal Convention, as determined at Montreal on May 28th, 1999, will apply.
- In case we expressly commit to arrange delivery of goods with other transport means (truck, rail, barge) the relevant mandatory provisions will apply.
- Regarding VAT: All our transactions are also subject to the Belgian VAT regulation. Please provide us with the necessary information if indemnity of VAT, according to Belgian VAT regulation, can be invoked.
- Please be advised that no insurance for the risks related to the shipment, the transport, the handling or the storage of the goods will be subscribed without a written permission and therefore all operations and activities as indicated in this offer are performed at the principal's risk.
- For payment conditions related to our invoices see determination in our individual price offers.
- If you instruct us to issue our invoice to a third Company, then you shall send us their proof of acceptance first. In case they don't pay, you will have the obligation to settle our invoice yourself.
